TRIP TO ISRAEL

The Israel Ambassador Series Journey is an eight-day, **high-touch** experience designed for leaders in the sectors of faith, marketplace, and government seeking a deeper, more truthful understanding of Israel. Moving from the northern borders of the Galilee and Golan Heights through the West Bank, Jerusalem, the Negev, and modern Tel Aviv, participants engage with Israel's biblical foundations, security realities, governance, and world-renowned market innovation firsthand. **Through curated access, trusted local partnerships, and meaningful teaching on land, prophecy, and modern statehood, this journey moves beyond tourism to form informed, relational ambassadors for Israel and the nations.**

About this trip

This 10-day, 9-night journey to Israel (August 3–12) is designed as an immersive ambassadorial experience, bringing together faith, statehood, innovation, and relationship. Traveling from Israel’s northern borders through Jerusalem, the Negev, and Tel Aviv, participants will encounter the land not only through Scripture and history, but through the lived realities of modern Israel. This journey is intentionally structured to move beyond tourism, offering meaningful engagement with the geography, people, and decisions shaping Israel today.

Spiritually, the trip provides grounded biblical teaching and prophetic context tied directly to the land itself. Participants will walk key biblical sites, engage difficult and often misunderstood narratives, and explore the significance of Israel’s restoration in both ancient and modern times. Times of teaching, reflection, and dialogue are woven throughout the journey, allowing space for personal processing, prayer, and shared learning. The goal is not only inspiration, but clarity—helping participants develop a mature, informed relationship with Israel rooted in faith and truth.

Practically, the journey includes curated access to leaders and institutions shaping the State of Israel today. This includes visits and briefings related to governance and statehood, with planned access to the Knesset, as well as exposure to Israel’s innovation, business, agriculture, and security sectors. Professional native guides, organized transportation, and hotel accommodations are provided throughout the trip to ensure a seamless experience. Together, these elements create a comprehensive journey that equips participants to return home as informed ambassadors—capable of engaging Israel with wisdom, confidence, and credibility.

Cost and Payment

The Swords Into Plowshares Ambassadors Series Journey will cost \$4,000 per person and \$7,500 per couple.

Upon registration, we will collect a \$1,000 deposit that is refundable up to 30 days before the scheduled arrival in Israel.

The total unpaid remainder for participants is due 30 days before the scheduled arrival in Israel.

After 30 days, any cancellations will result in the forfeiture of the deposit amount of \$1,000.

Day 1 – Arrival & Orientation (North)

- Arrival at Ben Gurion Airport
- Group travel by train north to Nahariya
- Hotel check-in near the Lebanese border
- Welcome dinner combined with orientation briefing
 - Overview of the journey
 - Israel's security realities, borders, and calling

Day 2 – Golan Heights & Northern Border

- Visit to the Golan Heights
- Briefing on Israel's northern security environment
- Overlooks toward Lebanon and Syria
- Visit to a military base
- Teaching and discussion on the biblical and strategic importance of the north

Day 3 – Galilee & Prophetic Landscape

- Travel through the Galilee
- Visit to Har Megiddo (Armageddon)
- Teaching on biblical prophecy and historical context
- Optional executive-level visit to select northern sites
- Evening reflection and group discussion

Day 4 – West Bank Immersion

- Full day in the West Bank hosted with local partners
- Education on land narratives and regional complexity
- Briefing on pressures facing local farmers and communities
- Discussion on the land development framework
- Biblical and prophetic teaching on Judea and Samaria
- Shared meal at a special local restaurant

Day 5 – Jerusalem: Past, Present & Shabbat

- Travel from the north to Jerusalem
- Mount of Olives overview
- Old City walk
- Western Wall visit
- Introduction to Jerusalem's spiritual and geopolitical significance
- Ambassador Shabbat dinner hosted by a local rabbi
- Overnight in Jerusalem

Day 6 – Jerusalem: Governance & Culture

- Visit to the Knesset (Israeli Parliament)
 - Guided tour
 - Optional meetings with Knesset members (subject to availability)
- Time at Mamilla Mall and Machane Yehuda Market
- Evening free time or group dinner
- Overnight in Jerusalem

Day 7: The South – Negev & Dead Sea

- Full day excursion to southern Israel
- Visit to the Dead Sea
- Briefing on the greening of the Negev
- Meeting with leaders in Israeli agricultural innovation
- Discussion on desert development, water, and food security
- Return north in the evening

Day 8 – Tel Aviv: Innovation & Culture

- Travel to Tel Aviv
- Introduction to modern Israeli society and culture

Travel & Logistics Note

Airfare to Tel Aviv is currently available for under \$500 round trip from Paris (CDG) and Rome (FCO), making this journey especially accessible for European participants.
